Classroom - 15 students; 2 adults - Girls Club. Students making T-shirts & pillows.

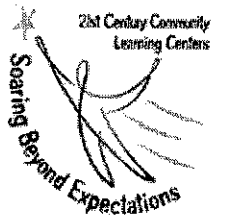
Classroom 13 students; 1 adult - Young Engineers, students are given their tables with new material for their projects.
